RESOLUTION

November 14, 1978

- WHEREAS: The Stockbridge-Munsee Community has posted its boundaries as a means of regulating hunting and fishing within its boundaries since 1974, and
- WHEREAS: Under the terms of the Stockbridge-Munsee Constitution,
 Article VII, Section 1 (f), the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribe
 has the authority (subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior) to so post its boundaries and to
 adopt rules and regulations governing hunting and fishing
 by tribal members within the reservation area and to regulate the use of Stockbridge-Munsee lands for such purposes
 to non-members, and
- WHEREAS: An ordinance to govern these regulations has been developed within the Stockbridge-Munsee Conservation Code, and
- WHEREAS: This Conservation Code and Resolution for Ordinance has been posted throughout the community for 15 days, and
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Tribal Council held a meeting on November 14, 1978, which was 15 days after the posting, to take final action on the resolution for ordinance, and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Stockbridge-Munsss Tribal Council is in support of the adoption of the Stockbridge-Munsee Conservation Code ordinance as modified.

CERTIFICATION
