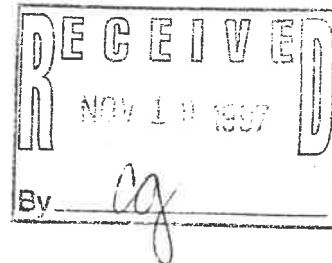

Dear Vice President Bowman:

The Chapter 16, Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Law, Public Peace and Good Order Ordinance, and Resolution No. 251-97 adopted October 7, 1997, by the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council is hereby approved. Approval of the Ordinance is granted pursuant to Article VII, Section 1(f) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Stockbridge-Munsee Community and pursuant to authority delegated to me in 10 BIAM 3.1 and Addendum to 10 BIAM 3.1 dated March 17, 1994.

We would like to suggest the Tribe correct the reference to the Stockbridge Munsee Tribal Council in the second sentence of the Statement of Purpose and Findings. We also suggest Shawano County, Wisconsin, be added to the "Reservation" definition which describes the two townships.

By copy of this letter, we are providing a copy of the approved documents to the Area Director, Minneapolis Area Office, who may, within 90 days from the date of enactment, rescind the action for any cause, by notifying you of such action.
