RESOLUTION

January 6th, 1998

No. 01-98

WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community, Band of Mohican Indians, is a federally recognized Indian tribe governed by the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council pursuant to authority vested in the Council by a Constitution approved in November 1937; and

WHEREAS, The Stockbridge Munsee Community has the authority under its constitution and its inherent rights as a sovereign nation to pass ordinances regulating the conduct of individuals within the exterior boundaries of the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community enacted the Employee Rights Ordinance, located at Chapter 53 of the Stockbridge-Munsee Ordinances, on June 28, 1995; and

WHEREAS, After observing the way the Ordinance works and considering those observations, the Tribal Council has concluded that certain portions of the Ordinance need to be revised and amended;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council hereby passes the attached revised and amended Stockbridge-Munsee Community Employee Rights Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any employee who has a grievance pending under the former Employee Rights Ordinance may elect to pursue his or her grievance under the new Ordinance as amended by this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this amended Employee Rights Ordinance shall take effect February 1, 1998.
