

- WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community, Band of Mohican Indians, is a federally recognized Indian tribe governed by the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council pursuant to authority vested in the Council by a Constitution approved in November 1937; and,
- WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community has the authority under its constitution and its inherent rights as a sovereign nation to adopt Ordinances and amendments; and,
- WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community adopted the Employee Preference Ordinance, as Chapter 54, on July 9, 1996; and,
- WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community desires to clarify that the Human Resources has the authority and duty to enforce Chapter 54, the Employee Preference Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council hereby adopts the attached amendments to Chapter 54, the Employee Preference Ordinance clarifying that Human Resources has the authority and duty to enforce the provisions of the Employee Preference Ordinance.
