RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community, Band of Mohican Indians, is a federally recognized Indian tribe with inherent sovereign powers, and is governed by the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council pursuant to the 1937 Constitution; and,

WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community has the authority under its Constitution and its inherent rights as a sovereign nation to adopt and amend Ordinances; and,

WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Fish and Wildlife Committee and the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council desire to substantially improve the existing Chapter 21, Fish and Game Regulations Ordinance, by clarifying numerous sections and bringing the enforcement provisions and other relevant provisions of Chapter 20 into Chapter 21; and,


WHEREAS, These changes have resulted in whole-scale changes to Chapter 21, including adding new sections and re-numbering, re-organizing and revising existing sections, and re-naming it as the Fish and Wildlife Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council hereby repeals the existing Chapter 21 and adopts the recommended changes as a new Chapter 21, the Fish and Wildlife Ordinance.

CERTIFICATION
